By agreeing to be a GoodSAM responder I acknowledge that I understand and agree to all of the following terms and conditions:

- 1. I respond at my own risk. Neither GoodSAM nor the ambulance service is responsible for any loss, damage or injury suffered by me when responding to, or attending an emergency.
- 2. It is my choice whether or not I respond to an emergency. I will not respond if it is unsafe for me to do so and I will not respond if I am impaired, for example by illness or alcohol consumption.
- 3. I understand that I should not have my phone on mute when responding, so that I can receive additional alerts from the ambulance service if required.
- 4. I understand that if additional information becomes available, for example the scene may be unsafe or the incident is no-longer a cardiac arrest that I will receive an additional alert of
